While we are in Japan we are so aware of the lack of spiritual interest by the Japanese, our own deficiencies in understanding the culture and language, and other struggles. We really depend on our prayer team to overcome these battles, and we are thankful that when God puts out a front line laborer in the harvest, He does so in a spiritual context of supportive prayer "backers."

When we come "home" (America), away from our "home" (Japan), the spiritual battle changes, but we still have battles to fight. These include dealing with discouragement, displacement, health issues, taking care of aging parents, meeting the needs of our children, as well as trusting God daily to keep raising our support to the level needed for our return. We can't keep going without your backing in prayer. Frankly, it's not easy traveling away from home with kids for 7 months.
