Scripture just always encourages me as I consider financial support issues. Invariably Philippians 1:3-9 comes to mind:



"It is right for me to feel this way about all of you, since I have you in my heart; for whether I am in chains or defending and confirming the gospel, all of you share in God's grace with me. God can testify how I long for all of you with the affection of Christ Jesus.

"And this is my prayer: that your love may abound more and more..."

As a missionary, consider this special relationship we have partnership. It involves so much more than just the finances. It is a "partnership in the gospel," in other words, a joint work so that the gospel may go forward and the kingdom of God expand! It is the spreading of the work of His kingdom that began in you and is going out from you. God each believer the gives privilege to be part of his growing kingdom, not merely by their own position in the kingdom, but by their faith spreading the kingdom message to others.


