Last month I mentioned that I would be hosting a Coverage Ministry conference with leaders of this outreach effort in East Asia in Tokyo. At the last minute the conference location was changed from Japan to Singapore and delayed until January (so I will be travelling there). The result is that I have more time to work with the teams here this month. God knows and works all things together for good.

After 23 years in Japan, we believe God is leading us to seek a stateside assignment with Campus Crusade. For several years we have thought that there may be a time when the needs of parents and family would need to be considered in our choice of location. As we have prayed and sought the Lord's leading about this huge decision, it seems that this June is the right time to return to the States. This time is a good time for our children, with graduating from Christian Academy in Japan in June. Melissa will be finished with 8th grade, enabling her to attend high school in the States.

carry on the ministry in our place. It has been exciting to see God answer those prayers and lead many to join our JCCC staff over the years. Now some of them are in key leadership positions and others are ready take the next step in leadership. As God is leading us on to a Stateside ministry, it has been great to see Him raise up those people who will take my place and expand the efforts so that the work here can grow I mentioned that even more. Keiko Kinoshita is being trained to work in HR, and she will take that responsibility from January. In the next 6 months I plan to train Koichi Takahashi, Knox Bannister, and Weng Kong Loh to take my Administration and Materials, Finance, and Mass Evangelism Strategies roles. Pray for fruitful and effective training times with these men.

We love Campus Crusade, and we have enjoyed and been blessed to serve the Lord here in Japan for 23 years. We never would have thought at the beginning that we would be here that long. Partly because we have served this long overseas, we desire a time of growing and developing in our own spiritual lives and ministries so we can minister with additional impact to the people to whom God leads us. A season sharpening our ministry skills in the US can be very helpful for future work God has for us.

We were already due to take a school year furlough from next summer. Now we are planning to join a 1 year program at the Worldwide Headquarters of Campus Crusade Orlando. in program, the "Lake Hart Stint," is especially designed for staff in transition and is recommended for people who have been serving outside the US for many years. It seems a perfect landing spot for our family and should give us good opportunities to see where the Lord is leading us for the future. Even though we will be stateside, our heart's desire is to be used to international serve the ministries and keep reaching Japanese in some way.

Please pray with us that the Lord will direct our steps. Pray for us as we begin to say goodby to our staff family and many, many Japanese friends missionary friends. Rochelle is planning to end her 2 English Bible classes, her discipleship time with Yamakawa-san, and her English "play time" with Joshua's friends and moms by March, so she can focus on the move. This is a very sad and hard thing to do. Her ministry with the PTA executive committee and the Mom's Sunday School class will continue until the end of the school year. She also has an opportunity to speak at a church's parenting seminar about teenagers on January 11.

Pray for our children who have to say goodbye to the only home country they have ever known. Melissa is especially having a difficult time with this as she wants to graduate from CAJ like her big brothers did. Please pray that God would use us greatly as His lights here during our remaining 6 months in Japan!
