We are glad to write you again from Florida and share some of God's work in our lives. Thank you so much for praying!

### JOSHUA 1

In our office devotional recently I was leading a time thinking about Joshua Chapter 1. I was looking at it and asking the question "Who is God in this chapter?" What does this chapter show us about who God is? I saw in verse 1 that God was giving the land to the Israelites. He was the sovereign owner of the land in the first place! In verse 5 I saw that God's presence would keep Joshua undefeatable. His presence ensures that His promises are fulfilled for us, just like they were for Joshua and the Israelites. In verse 7 I saw that God gives us instructions to make us successful. Real success is for the man who loves and follows those instructions of God's word. some facts about CCC to put this in context. CCC is the largest para-church missionary organization, with over 27,000 staff from over 170 different countries, who are all working hard to help fulfill the Great Commission of Jesus! Our organization has become a global organization, where Vice Presidents from all the major parts of the earth work with Steve Douglass, our President, to give direction to the whole movement. National offices are here for the US Campus Ministry and the Jesus Film Project. Major media ministries are here, such as Worldwide Challenge magazine, and several Internet

Projects impacting millions around the globe. And there are our Core Services, providing the administrative support that keeps our frontline staff going, including all the donations and financial services and human resources. All together there are over 950 people serving God at HQ!

The department where I am working this year is called HRX, for Human Resources ConneXion. This HR department serves US staff members overseas who are not in the Campus Ministry. (Campus has their own HR). We also serve the US staff members who work at the World HQ.
