As I was reading through the passage on the Resurrection in Matthew, I noticed that a great earthquake accompanied the resurrection of Christ. Here's the passage:

After the Sabbath, at dawn on the first day of the week, Mary Magdalene and the other Mary went to look at the tomb. There was a violent earthquake, for an angel of the Lord came down from heaven and, going to the tomb, rolled back the stone and sat on it. His appearance was like lightning, and his clothes were white as snow. The guards were so afraid of him that they shook and became like dead men. The angel said to the women, "Do not be afraid, for I know that you are looking for Jesus, who was crucified. He is not here; he has risen, just as he said. Come and see the place where he lay." Matthew 28:1-6

Our family felt many earthquakes during our years in Japan. Never "the big one." But, I, Steve, was in a big one in Manila in 1990. It was scary, hanging on to the walls and jumping up and down with the building! I didn't know what to do, but pray and wait for it to end. work in us to bring us His life every day. Even more on the glorious day of our resurrection! We have so much to be thankful for! We have a wonderful Savior!

We pray that this Easter might be encouraging to us all to realize afresh that God's power is available for us day by day. As Paul writes, "I also pray that you will understand the incredible greatness of God's power for us who believe him.
