STEVE'S SURGERY PLANS

Please pray for Steve's upcoming surgery to remove a tumor that has grown out of his pituitary. It is about the size of a walnut, just behind the eyes where the optic nerves cross. He found it by some blurriness in his vision that developed last fall. An MRI eventually showed it, and the neurosurgeon has scheduled its removal on July 12th.

Please ask God for complete healing and restoration of his evesight, for peace and a successful surgery. The recovery

should be 1-2 days in hospital and 4-6 weeks to fully recover. There may need to be some radiation afterwards to clear up any remaining tumor material so it doesn't regrow.

Thanks so much to the many who have already given to help with these medical expenses. There are still some costs to cover if you would like to help provide for them.

Rochelle and I are both disappointed that this surgery is preventing us from at-

tending our staff conference in Colorado. We will try to watch sessions that will be broadcast online, but we will greatly miss seeing our friends, the worship time with 5000 staff, and the excitement and momentum that is part of being there. But we know God is in control. and Josh
