I want to introduce you to my friend Momo from Japan. She is the daughter of Sachiko Katayama, a dear friend of mine who was in my English Bible Study class for about 10 years. Sachiko was already a believer in Christ when she attended my class. She was very faithful, teachable, and she helped me explain the Bible in Japanese when others in the class had questions or difficulties in English. She could explain it to them in Japanese!

Momo came to Orlando to be part of a homestay program that brings Japanese students to Orlando for a month long program. Momo was

here staying with another family, attending English and Bible classes in the mornings, and then going sightseeing and to theme parks and other adventures during the afternoons. After that month, she came to stay with our family for 10 more days. Little did we know when we made the plans that her days with us would coincide with Hurricane Irma!

Her first 2 days were filled with fun with the American Christian college students she met during the homestay program. But then they all got busy with their own preparations for the hurricane and she was stuck at home with us! I was busy shopping for water, food supplies, doing laundry and cleaning in case I couldn't do it during or after the storm. Steve was out lining up for sandbags and putting up plywood on a couple of windows with the help of Josh and our son-in-law Ben. Momo helped out where she could, did some homework, and showed me how she was reading through the Bible. She told me that her name Momo which by the sound means "peach" was taken from Gal 5:22-23, the fruit of the Spirit. Momo joined us for prayer and Bible reading, following along in her Japanese Bible, before going to bed.

During the 2 days when the storm hit, the water came into her room soaking the carpet near the wall, and then the electricity went out, Momo kept a positive attitude. We set up
