She was also willing to talk with us, and Emma began to share, asking her the first two questions. We got to know her a little through what she saw in the different photos. She then shared about what she experienced spiritually and asked to hear what we believe about Jesus. We shared that it is by grace we can know God and receive the abundant, eternal life He offers through faith in Jesus (Ephesians 2:9-10). She said that she wanted to pray and put her faith in Jesus!

What a joy it was to see Emma take a step of faith out of her comfort zone and see God work through her in a major way to bring someone to faith in Him!

I am confident that God really is doing a new thing in this city and believe this is the first of many students we will see trust in Him! Please join us in prayer for more response in Philly!.
