As we send out staff members, they often find that students from other countries are very interested in learning about Christ and His offer of salvation. Andrew from our Boston Cru team shared this story of the impact they can have.



"Keyven, one of only 18 students from Mozambique studying in the U.S., dreams of becoming his nation's president. He is now a senior at Bentley University. Through the experience of discipling Keyven these past four years, Boston Cru staff member Andrew considers these dreams realistic.

For a couple of years, Keyven's Venezuelan roommate, Edgardo, passively watched Keyven's life and words testify of Jesus. This fall, Edgardo's interest ramped up to active curiosity. He decided he wanted to go with Keyven to the weekly Cru meeting.

At Keyven's request, Andrew agreed to meet and share the gospel with Edgardo afterward. "With each verse and concept, he got hungrier and hungrier," noted Andrew. Understanding Jesus' sinless life exchanged for ours, Edgardo's concern that he couldn't be "good enough" disappeared. He marveled, "So this is what Keyven meant...about Jesus being the bridge."

Gratitude flowed as Edgardo trusted in Jesus, along with hugs. Now, during his shift at the Student Center help desk, Edgardo reads the study Bible gifted to him. He also passionately shares his newfound faith at Cru meetings. A few weeks ago, a student from Japan expressed how deeply influenced he was by Edgardo's story.

God is always working, making these special connections as staff and students step out in faith to share and live out the gospel! We are glad to be part of this work by sending out the new Cru missionaries and helping staff discover the different places they can serve the Lord.
