It's been a good year for me. I have been working as a Shift Manager at Panera Bread, but God has called me to get out of the restaurant industry and to jump into something else. As a result, this next year I have been given the opportunity to go with Cru (Campus Crusade for Christ), on a short term international mission trip (or STInt) to Tokyo, Japan!!

I can honestly say, up until a few years ago this was something I would have never chosen for myself. "Missionary" was *nowhere* on my potential job wish-list. I loved that my parents were missionaries to Japan and that I got to grow up there, but I never wanted it for myself.

However, after the earthquake and tsunami rocked Japan, God put into motion His slow yet steady call on me to return to Japan. I went with CRASH Japan for three weeks in the summer of 2011 to help with relief work, and it opened my eyes and broke my heart. I can still see the mounds of trash piled higher than buildings in the streets after the tsunami had crushed the land. I can still hear the old couple thank our team over and over again as we watered flowers that had been planted in the rubble of their home.

As a result of that trip, I went on a summer mission trip with Cru last year, for 5 weeks. I had a great time, yet was shown again how strong the grip is that the enemy has over the hearts of the Japanese people. There is so much need for the life and light of Jesus in their hearts. The darkness is palpable, and the mundane etched into faces you pass along the way. There is no true satisfaction, no full joy, nor lasting hope. Just this one life and the best they can make of it. But Hallelujah! We were able

to see God save 3 students we had met and gotten to know during those 5 weeks!

So now here I go again, with a team of 5 other people, and this time for a full year. Our mission is to see college students come to know Jesus, and to give them an opportunity to accept Him as their Savior. Our mission is to live and love the Japanese as Jesus does, with the hopes of seeing even one person come to believe in Jesus. In a land where less than 1% of the population professes to be Christian, there is a huge
