Hello! I hope that this letter finds you well. I would like to thank you for your continued love, prayer and support for myself and my family over the years. Now, here is another opportunity for you to get involved in my life and my journey as I will be heading off on a relief trip to Japan very soon!

As you are aware, in March a great earthquake struck the nation of Japan, and a tsunami followed, causing terrible loss, panic, pain, and crippling a country of kind-hearted, hard-working and spiritually lost people. Also, as I'm sure you know, Japan is the country I was born in, the land I grew up in, and the place I can most easily call home. Of course, as soon as I heard, I sent emails and Facebook comments to all my friends that live in Japan making sure they were okay. Thank the Lord that all of my friends and their families were protected and remained safe!

While it was all happening, a part of me wanted to just leave everything at the first chance and go help Japan. Unfortunately, here I was, on the other side of the world in Florida, attending the University of Central Florida, working at Panera Bread, and still trying to convince myself I belong here. As things began to settle down, the news stories quickly turned to the latest thing. It became a rare thing to read about Japan in the news again, and as college and work kept going, I slowly forgot about the Japanese and their pitiful plight.

Then, in May, my mom sent me an email about an opportunity to go to Japan with Campus Crusade for Christ and CRASH (Christian Relief, Assistance, Support, and Hope) Ministries to be a part of a relief effort. Later, a family friend also challenged and encouraged me to apply for the same mission trip.
